



## One Step Closer: Governor Sisolak Extends Vaccine Availability

Vaccine availability extends to include people ages 65-69. Previously only available to ages 70 and up in most counties, Sisolak says that all 17 counties of Nevada can start scheduling vaccination appointments for Nevadans aged 65 and up, beginning on February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Due to limited supply, not all Nevadan's in this age group will be able to get vaccinated. Some limitations may apply in certain counties, and vaccinations within this age group will be limited to pharmacies enrolled in the federal pharmacy partnership program, which as of now, Walmart is the only location listed on the CDC website.

Despite the initial limited locations and supply, this is certainly a positive step for Nevada, as schools, restaurants, sports, and entertainment are beginning to slowly see lifted restrictions following the downward trend of Covid cases in Nevada.
